Additionally, the School has offered Snow Shoes to all participants for the season which we are hoping to have available on Saturday for check out.

Log Cabin Ski Society is supporting getting Skagway's youth outside this winter through a diverse set of activities. All activities and locations are weather dependent and will be announced ahead of time. If conditions allow, skiing will be the primary activity. EARLY RELEASE - THURSDAY

(January 21st, February 4th & 25th, March 4th & 18th)

4th - 12th Graders

2:30pm - 4:30 pm

- Meet outside the school near the elementary end doors @ 2:20pm
- Transport: Parent facilitated drop-off and pick-up to the activity location of the day
- Covid mitigation protocols must be adhered to at all times (See below)

SATURDAYS

Every Saturday through March

9:30 am - 1:30 pm

- Kids of all ages and families welcome - 3rd graders and younger must be accompanied by an adult in their Covid bubble
- Location TBD weekly
- Families will meet at the designated activity site at 9:30 am
- Transport: Parent facilitated drop-off and pick-up to the activity location of the day
- Covid protocols must be adhered to at all times (see below)

COVID 19 PROTOCOL:

These protocols must be adhered to at ALL times during Ski Club!

- 6 foot distancing at school and during the activity
- Masks worn on school property (yellow zone)
- Mask must be available in child's pocket during activity in case the leader needs to help the child with ski/snowshoe/first-aid, in which case both will wear a mask when within 6ft
- Sanitize hands before & after snacks
- Food and equipment is not shared
- Equipment will be checked out for the duration of the program.
